Application must be received ON OR BEFORE JUNE 15, 2017 to reserve a booth for \$80.00. MA'AM booth fees are not payable until Jury selection is completed. All payments must be made by July 24th to secure booth space. Payments may also be made on our website by clicking on the donate button and noting "MA'AM" in the comment section of the payment area or mail payment to World Museum of Mining, PO Box 33, Butte, MT 59703.

MINER'S ART & ANTIQUE MARKET 2017 RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION: The Miner's Art & Antique Market is scheduled for August 19, 2017, and will run from 11 am to 6 pm. An \$80.00 entry fee is due upon acceptance after jurying.

ADMISSION: Admission to MA'AM is regular Museum admission: \$8.50 adults, \$7.00 seniors, and \$5.00 youth. Underground Tours are an additional cost.

ART: All items must be the work of the vendor. All items must be handmade. No mass produced items will be accepted. In order to ensure the quality of the show, vendors are asked to keep their art specific to their specialty.

ANTIQUe: All items sold in the market must be considered antique or vintage. Modern items are not permitted. Items should be displayed in a clean and organized fashion. Any handmade items sold in the market used to enhance displays must follow the art guidelines as stated above.

During the show all booths will be observed by WMM staff to uphold the rules and regulations of the market. If items displayed do not conform to the items juried, WMM staff will ask that the non-conforming items be removed from the area. If this request is not WMM will ask the vendor to leave the premises without refund.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Before July 24th, no penalty. July 24th or later, full payment is required and nonrefundable.

COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT: You must have a license agreement to sell any item that has trademark or copyright. Any suspicious items will be required to be removed from display.

EMERGENCY CONTACTS: In case of emergency, the emergency contact on the application will be notified. An emergency contact must be provided by all vendors. If vendor must be taken to hospital, it will be the emergency contact's responsibility to pick up stand, craft, personal belongings and vehicle. The World Museum of Mining will not be responsible for vendors or their possessions.

ENTRY FEE: \$80.00 due after jury process and by July 24, 2017. Make checks payable to **WORLD MUSEUM OF MINING**. If entry fee is not received by this date, vendor will forfeit their booth. Returned checks will be charged a \$25.00 fee.

FOOD VENDORS: All food sold at MA'AM must be cleared by the Butte-Silver Bow County Health Department. It is up to the vendor to ensure that they have the appropriate license. Proof of license must be on file by July 24th or food vendor will forfeit their booth.

JURYING: All MA'AM applicants will be juried. Vendors will be juried based on submitted photos and bios. It is the intent of MA'AM to select quality products to be sold at the market.

LIABILITY: The World Museum of Mining will not be responsible for injury, loss or damage that occur to lessee on signing the contract, the vendor expressly releases the aforementioned from any and all claims for such loss, damage or injury. By signing this application, vendor indemnifies and holds harmless the World Museum of Mining.

PETS: NO PETS will be allowed in the market area as the Museum is a no pet facility. Service dogs are permitted with appropriate papers.

PHOTOS: Vendors are asked to submit five photos with their applications. One photo must be of vendor's booth set up. All photos will become the property of the World Museum of Mining and may be used for promotional purposes.

PROMOTION: Vendors are required to submit bios (500 words or less) about themselves and their product. This information will be used in the jurying process and used in festival press releases and promotions as well as all submitted photos.

SET UP: Set up will start at 6:30 am on the day of the event. No early set up is allowed. All vehicles must be removed from museum grounds by 10:45 am.

SMOKING: The World Museum of Mining is a nonsmoking facility. No smoking is permitted on site during the Market. If you plan to smoke, you must exit the grounds through the gift shop and cross the parking lot.

SPACE ASSIGNMENTS: All booth spaces will be assigned by the MA'AM committee. All vendor booths are outdoors.

SPACE REQUIREMENTS: All booth spaces will be 10' deep by 10' wide. This area must be kept clean. Vendors must provide their own tents. Tent or canopy ropes may not extend outside the 10' by 10' area. No electricity is available in the market area. If you are bringing a generator, please note that on your application. **NOTE: The area does tend to get windy. Please be sure to bring weights for your tents.**

TABLES AND TENTS: Tables, tents and chairs must be provided by each vendor. The World Museum of Mining does not have any available for rent or to borrow.

TEAR DOWN: Vendors must maintain their booth space until 6:00 pm. Vehicles will not be permitted for re-entry until that time. If items must be removed before market close, all items will have to be packed out by foot.

VEHICLES: Vehicles will not be permitted in the juried market area from 10:45 AM to 6:00 PM. This is for the safety of Museum guests. There will be a designated parking area for vendors. There is no cost for parking. Additional information will be posted and sent by July 31.
